Everyone who donates will receive a free one day ticket to the Clark County Fair. The blood drive starts at 11:00 a.m. and donors will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. in the Manz Conference Room. Anyone who is at least 16-year-olds with parental consent, weighs a minimum of 110 pounds and is in generally good health can donate blood. The entire process takes about an hour and all blood types are needed. Donors should bring a photo ID.

By making the decision to donate, you are helping accident victims, people undergoing surgery and cancer patients in your community. One unit of blood can affect the lives of three people.
